Harbour provided project management, construction engineering and inspection services to the Chicago Department of Transportation and the Chicago Park District for the supervision of construction of Burnham Park. The Park was constructed in conjunction with the relocation of Lake Shore Drive.

In 1996, the northbound lanes of Lake Shore Drive were relocated to the west side of Soldier Field. This created developable land adjacent to Burnham Harbor and near Soldier Field, Field Museum and Shedd Aquarium.

Burnham Park was constructed, installing bikepaths, walkways and green spaces for public use along the lakefront. 18th Drive was created adjacent to Lake Shore Drive to facilitate vehicles using Soldier Field, Burnham Harbor and McCormick Place. A revenue control system was installed for the Soldier Field parking lots.
