**Harbour** was selected as the General Contractor for the new 23<sup>rd</sup> District Police Station, which will replace the existing police station located at 3600 N. Halsted. The current station was built in the 1930's and does not have adequate space or amenities to service the Town Hall District. The new station will consist of a two story 44,000 square foot masonry building with a design based on the prototype for other new police stations that have been built throughout the City. The project is designed to accommodate a staff of 450 people over three shifts and will contain male/female locker rooms, roll call room, exercise room, sally-port, holding cells, interview rooms, evidence areas, 100 seat community room, administrative and general offices and a 150 foot communications tower.
