Harbour served as Construction Manager for the Oak Brook Public Library project. The 26,000 SF library was completed in 2002, simultaneously with the Oak Brook Municipal Complex project.

The design of the library is geometrically unique in that it is circular in plan with a serpentine perimeter, which is hexagonal in geometry. Due to the uniqueness of the design, the building has a sunscreen required to reduce the solar loads, which cantilevers out from the perimeter wall. The construction of the exterior features horizontal lapped cedar, combined with aluminum and glass. Finally, the main feature of the library is its fabricated steel frame dome ceiling.
