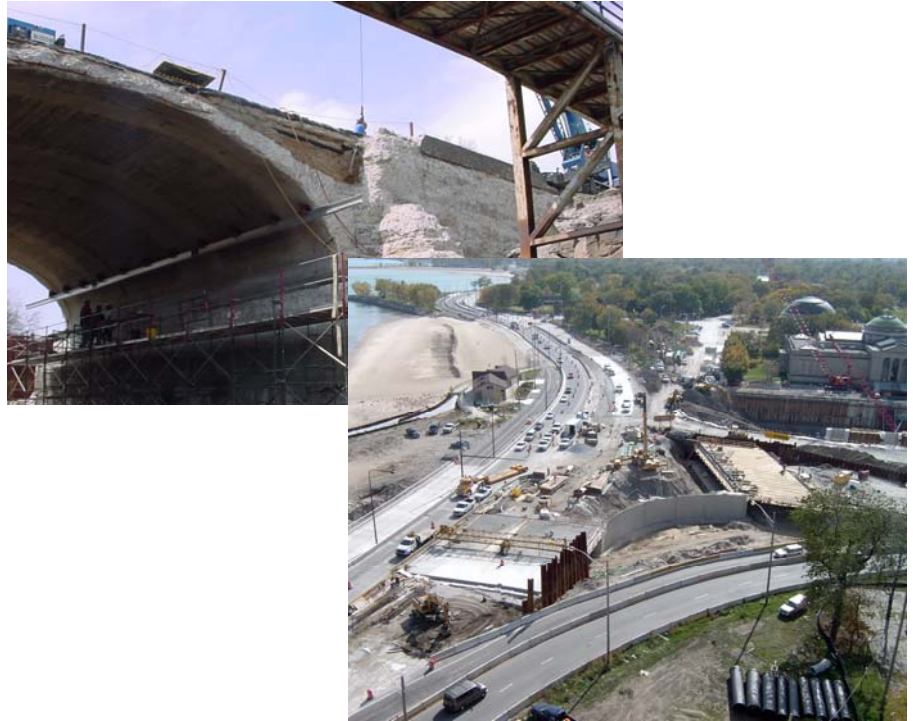

Harbour provided construction, engineering, and inspection services to the Chicago Department of Transportation for the reconstruction of South Lake Shore Drive from 57th Drive to 67th Street.

South Lake Shore Drive is Chicago's scenic gateway from the South. Its breathtaking views of Lake Michigan and beautiful parks are a great introduction to Chicago's vibrant skyline. As transportation, recreation and tourism have grown, so have traffic volumes. In 2000, South Lake Shore Drive had more than 100,000 daily users. Heavy traffic and the seasonal weather contrasts have led to a crumbling road.

The outlook for South Lake Shore Drive is brighter. More than 6 miles of the roadway – from 23rd to 67th Streets – will be rebuilt. The City of Chicago, Illinois Department of Transportation, and the Federal Highway Administration are investing \$162 million in its future.

The new section included new roadway, sewer & lighting installations as well as the addition of 5 new pedestrian underpasses, giving the lakefront easy pedestrian access from Jackson Park.
